THE NEED

We are investing in the lives of children with the most complex needs so they can live their life of significance and joy.

Some children and young adults with IDD require advanced, high intensity behavioral support. They cannot live in conventional community-integrated programs but require more advanced staffing and interventions.

- These behavioral supports address physical aggression, self-injurious behavior, elopement, and property destruction, to name a few.

With these interventions, behaviors can be impacted so significantly that as clients grow into adulthood, community-integrated living becomes possible.

THE PROGRAM

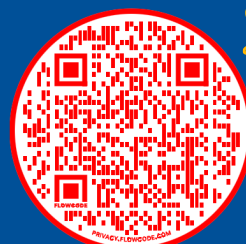
Individualized, person-centered service and behavioral support plans with 24 hour-care, medical care, and supervision by highly trained behavioral support specialists.

Our program will include advanced practices to impact the lives of children and young adults with high intensity support needs.

- Applied Behavior Analysis interventions and strategies.
- Psychiatric and physiologic consultations.
- Special attention to nutrition with dietician approved menu choices.
- Daily instruction on living skills, personal hygiene, safety, wellness, and independency
- A focus on recreational therapy and activity on a sprawling, park-like property.
- Heightened security with perimeter fence, indoor and outdoor security cameras, and delayed egress paths.
- Behaviorally hardened homes (shielded televisions, reinforced walls, water-resistant bathrooms, window shielding, and specially designed furniture).
